1. Definitions

2. Types of Data We Collect

3. How We Use Your Personal Data

We may use our personal data for the following purposes:

- **To Provide and Improve Our services:** This includes managing your account, processing payments, and communicating with you regarding your bookings.
- **Marketing**: We may send you promotional information about services or events similar to those you have already shown an interest in, unless you opt out.
- For Legal Compliance: To comply with legal obligations, enforce our agreements, and protect our rights.

We may share your personal data in the following situations:

- With Service Providers: We work with third-party companies to perform certain functions on our behalf, such as payment processing or data analysis.
- For Business Transactions: In the event of a merger, sale, or acquisition, your personal data may be transferred.
- With Your Consent: if you consent, we may share your personal information for specific purposes.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to track activity on our website and to improve our services. You can manage your cookie settings through your browser settings.

6. Data Retention

We retain your personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this policy, and as required for legal, regulatory, or contractual obligations.

7. Your Rights and Choices

- Access and Update: You can access, update, or delete your personal data at any time by logging into your account or contacting us directly.
- **Opting Out:** You can opt out of receiving promotional emails by following the unsubscribe link provided in each email.
- **Data Deletion:** You have the right to request deletion of your personal data, except when retention is required by law.

8. Security of Your Data

We take reasonable measures to protect your personal data from unauthorised access, alteration and disclosure. However, no method of transmission over the internet is 100% secure, so we cannot guarantee complete security.
